RENTAL CONDITIONS

- Renters must sign a release of liability and waiver of claims.
- Any damaged or lost gear will be charged to the renter at full retail price.
- A late return penalty will be charged at the daily rate.
- There is a \$20 clean boat fee if boat is brought back dirty.
- If a purchase of canoe or kayak is made within thirty days of the rental date, the rental fee of up to \$100 may be deducted from the purchase price with a valid sales receipt.
- Weekend rental is two days if picked up after 12 p.m. on Friday and returned by 12 p.m. on Mon.
- Long weekend rates are three days if picked up Friday after 12 p.m. and returned by 12 p.m. Tues.
- After hours pick up or drop off can be arranged.

CANCELLATIONS

- To reserve a rental we will request a credit card. If said rental is not picked up by closing time on the date booked your credit card will be charged full price for the reservation.
- Please let us know if there are any changes to your reservation such that we can free up the boat to others and not charge you for boats you don't need.

MULTI DAY RENTAL CANOEING/KAYAKING EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST

PFD (life jacket), Paddles, Pump or Bailer, Throwline, waterproof flashlight, repair kit (duct tape, pliers, wire, etc., sufficient food and clothing, complete rain gear, paddling jacket, Proper footwear, first aid kit, fire making capability, pocket knife, sun protection, maps or charts, Litter bag.

SAFETY GUIDELINES

- Develop your paddling skills including braces, rolls and rescues.
- Get into the habit of always bringing safety equipment for every trip.
- Wear clothing appropriate for weather and water conditions.
- Let someone know where you will be going and when you may be expected to return.
- Let us know where you are going, contact phone number, and emergency contact.
- Become familiar with the area you are planning to paddle in.
- Get a weather forecast for each day, be sensitive to changes in the wind, clouds, temperature, etc. The most important danger is hypothermia. Learn about hypothermia, dress appropriately.
- Wear a personal flotation device (life jacket) at all times. Carry extra flotation for river trips, and always scout ahead.
- Install bow and stern lines.
- Secure boat properly to carrying vehicle. Use approrite ropes for tieing down the boat. 1/2 line is reccommended. Ensure your vehicle has secure places to tie ropes to including under the front and back bumpers as well as the roof rack.
